



Help us work for a better Watton

Over recent months Watton Town Council has carried out a series of events as part of a Neighbourhood Development Planning process in order to gather the views of its residents and supporting evidence to produce a Neighbourhood Plan.

Neighbourhood Plans are intended to give local people a direct say in the future development of their area. The Plan gives local people the chance to create a planning document that guides and shapes development in their local communities. In turn, this will help to influence what facilities are provided in the area. The Plan will establish a vision for the area, include general policies for the development and use of land and bring forward sites for development. It will focus on local, rather than strategic issues.

The Town Council is also using this process to hear about other issues and concerns that you may have about how the Town functions now and in the future in serving its community.

So this Questionnaire is the final part of the evidence gathering process that will help the Council take account of your views on a whole range of issues around how you think the Town should look, how the community lives and operates in the future.

Like all local Town Councils, Watton Town Council has limited duties and powers however it will use the evidence gathered to influence all development along with other programmes and policies for the Town over the coming years.

We all lead busy lives and time during the festive season is very limited however we ask that you spend around 20 minutes now to influence how Watton looks, feels and meets the needs of its community in 20 years time.
