

Loch Neaton Lifebuoy Station Project

In August of last year the Loch Neaton Management Committee applied to Watton Town Council for a grant in the sum of £500 to purchase two new Lifebuoy Stations for installation at the Loch to supplement the one existing station.

The council approved our application and we are pleased to report that the stations were purchased over the winter and installed by our volunteers in March of this year.





The Stations, Rings and Ropes are made of polypropylene so will not rot or deteriorate with age. The support poles are also of a reinforced fiberglass design so are rust free.
