REPORT TO WATTON TOWN COUNCIL 16.4.2019

May I start by thanking the Town Council for their generous grant of £500 for our new Roland Electric Piano to accompany us at our rehearsals on Monday evenings.

Last year we gave 3 main concerts. The first at Bridgham Church to raise money for Muscular Dystrophy in memory of my predecessor David O'Neill, who died of this dreadful affliction in his late 50s. The second was in the Lincoln Hall, Hingham in memory of our late member Anthea Iveson, where we raised money for several the many charities that she had supported in her lifetime, including The Girl Guides and Riding for the Disabled.
