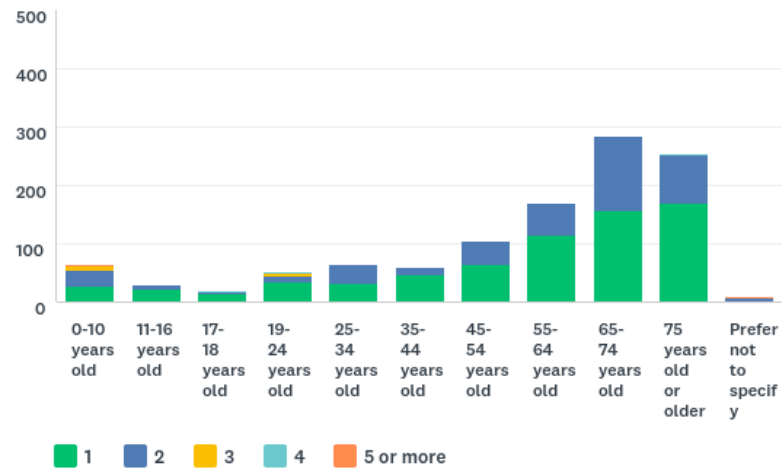


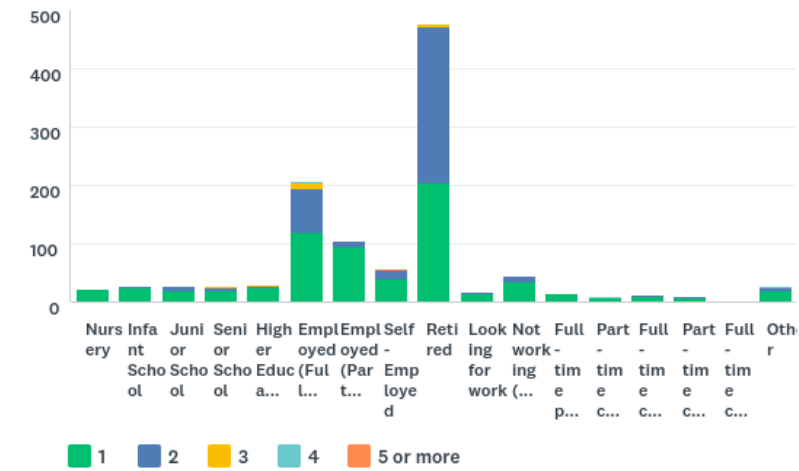

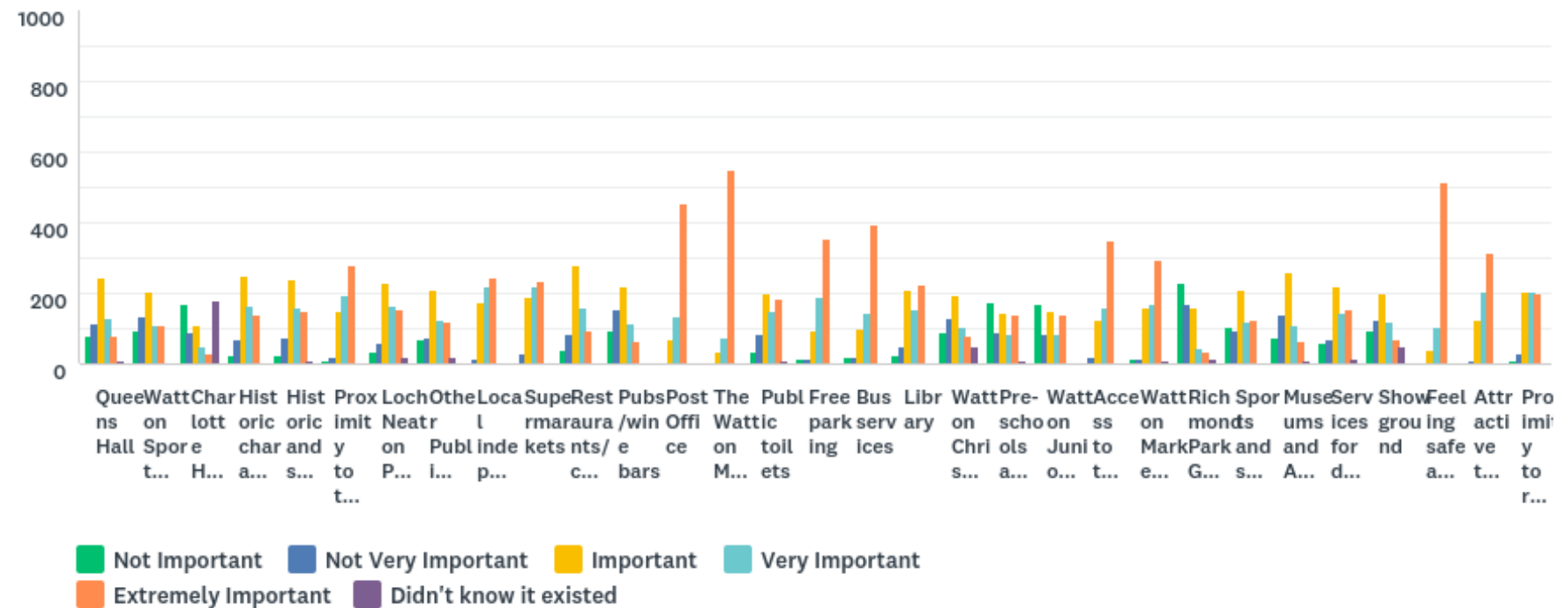
Q2 Please indicate the number of people living in your household in the following age categories.



Q4 Please indicate the numbers in your household in full-time education or engaged in each of the following employment categories.



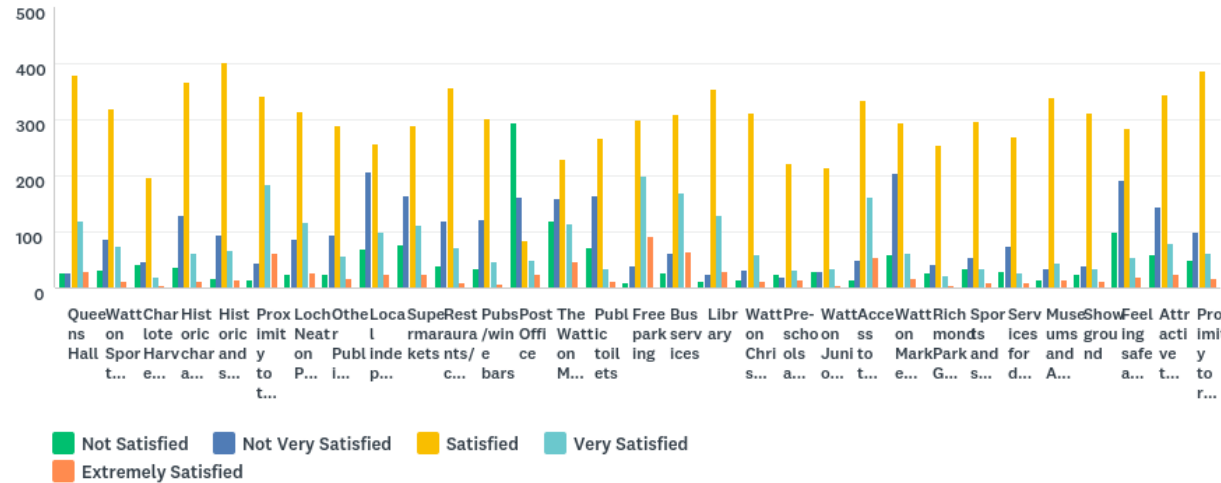

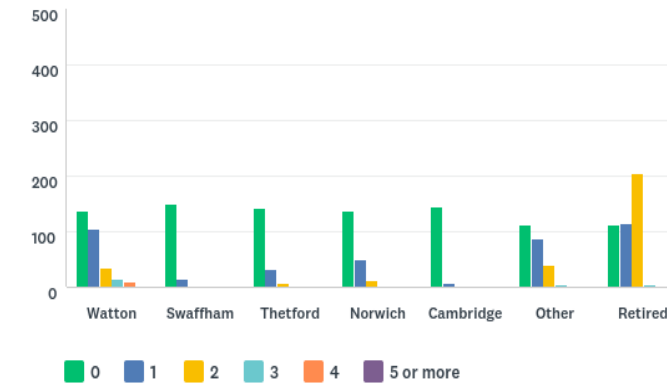

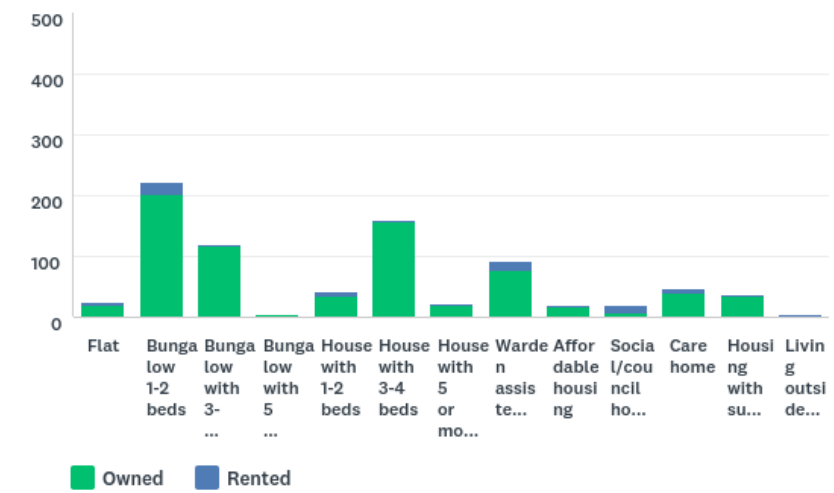
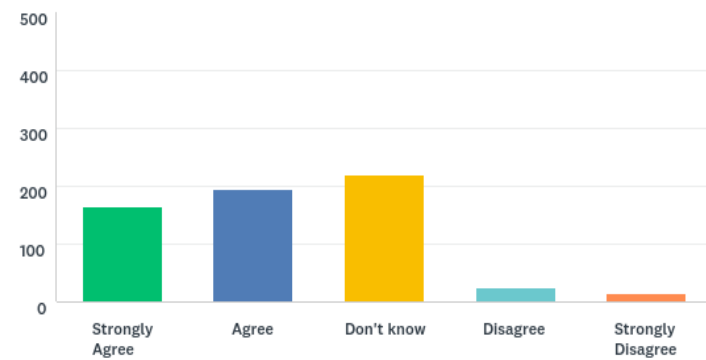


Q9 Please indicate how many members of your household work or study in the following locations

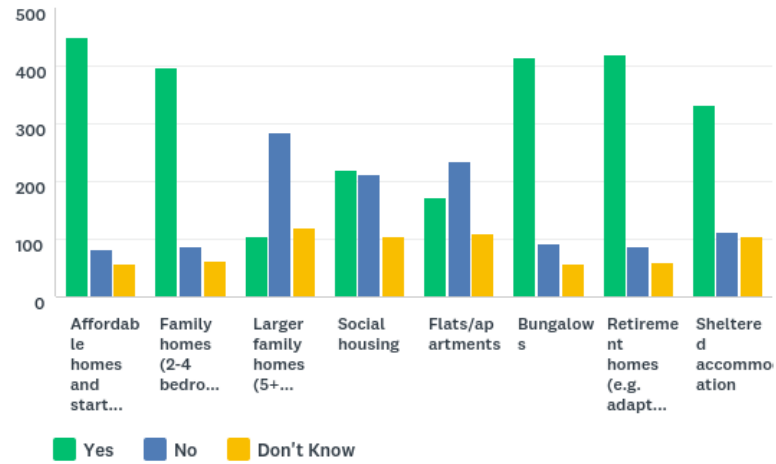

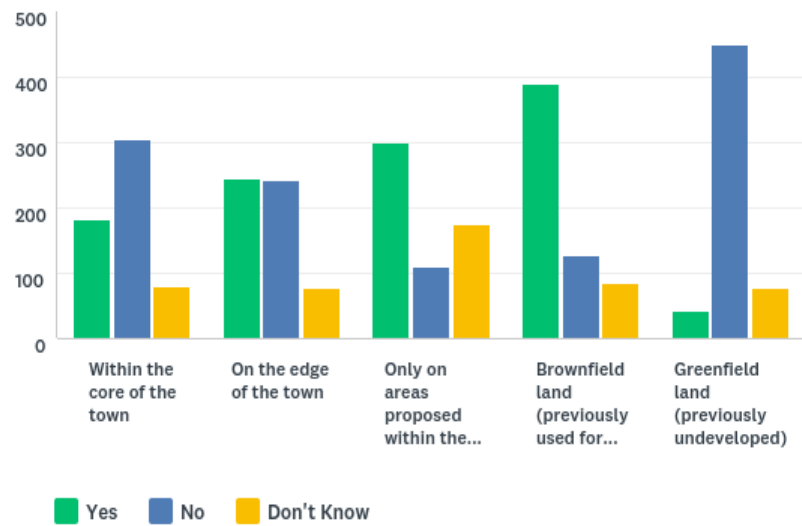

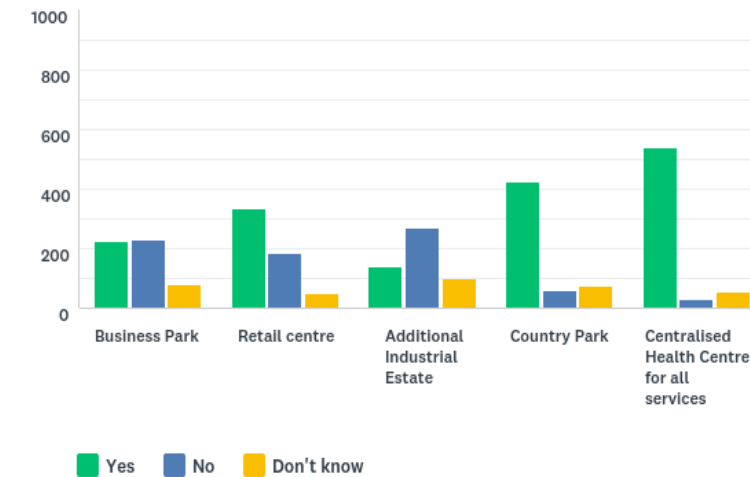

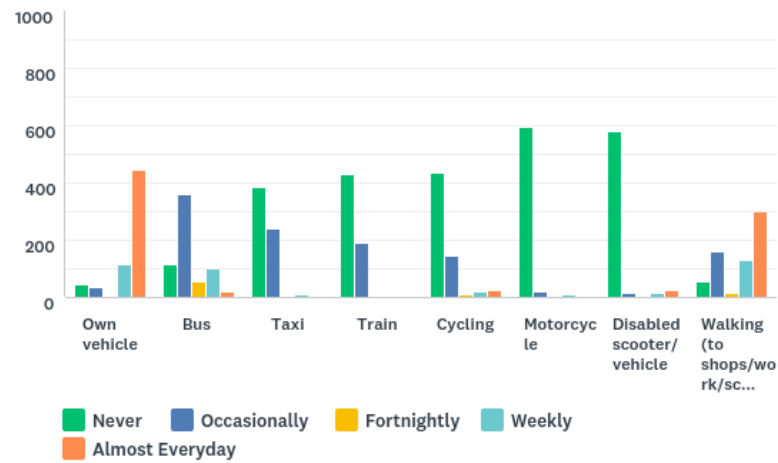
Q19 Watton is a Market Town set in a rural landscape. Which of the views or approaches to or from the Town that maintain its rural setting are important to you?



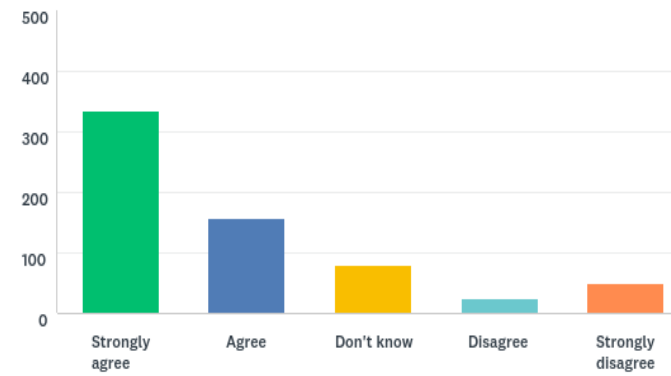
