The grant we received enabled us with other club funds to provide a patio type area and raised flower beds around the site together with weed free areas covered with weed suppressant and a shingle covering

Our aim was to provide a better lawn bowls facility within Watton in order to promote the benefits of bowls through social contact exercise fun wellbeing and companionship.

We believe that we have achieved this aim the raised beds provided via the grant are currently being planted up and we have areas where anybody can sit and watch a game or if they feel like they would like to give it a try any Tuesday or Thursday from 2pm till 4pm starting from the 18th April they can.
