During 2023 one of our biggest projects was to build a new boardwalk parallel with the

railway embankment so that those with mobility issues could utilise this path and we are pleased to say BDC provided us with £30,000 to build this new boardwalk and related infrastructure.

Many people have asked us about planting memorial trees and unfortunately, we wouldn't have sufficient space to meet all requests so instead we decided to build a Rose Garden, raised up so no one has to bend down to look at the roses. The basic structure is now finished, and it will be painted blue and planted over the next few weeks.

Our plan is that people will be able to sponsor either a Memorial Plaque or a Rose and Plaque and we will publish details shortly.

2024 is the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of D Day and on the 6<sup>th</sup> June we will jointly hold a commemorative event with the Sports Centre and light the loch beacon.

The beacon will be lit at 21.15 with a procession from the Sports Centre at 20.40

We hope as many people as possible will come to remember the 156,000 soldiers, airmen and sailors who took part in the Normandy landings.
